- 1) Revitalized our congregation with about 36 new households (containing around 83 new people), many of whom are young adults and children.
- 2) Developed a new goal for intergenerational congregational ministry.
- 3) Recalibrated our vision for intimacy and invitation.
- 4) Started a community garden.
- 5) Began a new outreach with Model School.
- 6) Modified the starting time of worship from 9:00 to 9:30.
- 7) Created a Fall Fest.
- 8) Modernized our web presence and church office procedures.

Leadership

- 9) Revised our 30-year-old congregational structure, distinguishing between the roles of visioning and programming, and creating two new major committees (the SLT and the Caregiving Commission).
- 10) Successfully navigated the pastoral transition from Anita to Marilyn.
- 11) Have begun another pastoral transition from Lois to a third pastor.
- 12) Smoothly navigated the transitions from Eleanor to Rafael to Priscillah.

Facilities

- 13) Bought a house and an acre of land with donations and internal loans.
- 14) Completed 2 major renovation projects and paid for them without borrowing money.
- 15) Replaced half the chairs in the sanctuary.
- 16) Put a new roof over the sanctuary (in process).
