From September through December 2022, we moved through the Old Testament, focusing on stories related to Creation, the Exodus, the Law, and Israel’s judges, kings, and prophets.

Four Months: One Gospel

From January through April 16, 2023, we will move sequentially through the book of Matthew to explore stories about Jesus’ life and ministry, including his teachings, parables, crucifixion, and resurrection. Focusing on one gospel during these months allows us to have a deeper sense of Matthew’s flow, unique perspective, and message.

During these months, everyone is encouraged to read through Matthew as we explore it together!
